Tanzanian Treasures sells commercial, hand dyed, and wax resist batik fabrics purchased in Tanzania, East Africa. We handle fat quarters, one yard cuts, dress lengths, quilt blocks and backs, kits and patterns. We also sell patterns, and jewelry, clothing, paintings, quilts by African artisans.

50 % of each purchase supports the Tanzanian Women's Scholarship Fund providing tuition, board, and room. The other 50% goes to the artisan.

We sell by appointment, at quilt shows, our programs or trunk shows. Our annual Quilt Retreat "Tanzanian Fabric, Fun, and Facts" is February 26 to 28, 2017 at Carol Joy Holling Camp Ashland, NE..

Our wax resist batik is purchased from local artisans and the Moshi Co-op. The needed hand dyed and discharged fabrics are made at Angaza Women's Training Center, the Moshi Co-op, & local artisans.
